A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2021-2022 FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the St. Clair City Council has established fees for services for all departments of the City; and

WHEREAS, the St. Clair City Council has incorporated as part of the 2022 Fiscal Year Budget a Fee Schedule which shall set the various fees of the City for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the St. Clair City Council desires to amend the fee schedule to reflect increases in the cost of providing existing services and to implement new fees required by the City's Sewer Use Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following changes be made to the 2022 Fiscal Year Fee Schedule:

1. The following fee is amended as follows:

2. The following fee is added to the "Office Services" section of the Fee Schedule
