2026 CATCH BASIN REPAIR PROGRAM
JAY STREET – RIVERSIDE AVENUE TO 8TH STREET
ADAMS STREET – 7TH STREET TO WEST OF 10TH STREET
3RD STREET – JAY STREET TO ADAMS STREET

Through a selective bidding process, the City of St. Clair has awarded Great Lakes Contracting Solutions of Waterford, Michigan the contract to replace or partially reconstruct failing catch basins along sections of Jay Street, Adams Street and 3rd Street. Great Lakes Contracting Solutions will begin to mobilize equipment this week and weather dependent, plans to start work on Wednesday, April 1. It is anticipated this work will be completed in approximately 3-4 weeks. During the course of construction, you should expect the following:

Traffic Control and Parking

All streets will remain open to traffic during construction and all driveways will be maintained for access. During working hours, please park all vehicles within your driveway or on adjacent side streets to allow the contractor to efficiently work between the hours of 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday through Friday. As catch basins are reconstructed and new concrete pavement is placed around the catch basin, the area around the catch basin will be barricaded off for at least 7 days to allow concrete to properly cure.

Dust Control

The Contractor, on a regular basis, will sweep the construction site and adjacent side streets during construction to control dust as much as possible; however, this will be an active construction zone and dust will exist and should be expected.

Irrigation Systems

If you are within the construction zone and have a lawn irrigation system that may be located behind the back of curb near a catch basin, it is recommended you mark or flag

the location of any sprinkler heads located between the street and the sidewalk and along the back edge of the sidewalk to prevent unnecessary damage to your system. If irrigation systems are accidentally damaged, the Contractor will be required to replace as part of the restoration phase of the project.

Vegetative Restoration

Disturbance of lawn areas adjacent to catch basins will be minimal. However, any disturbed lawn will be replaced with topsoil and seed at the completion of the project. The Contractor will be responsible for establishing vegetative growth.

Garbage Pick-Up/Mail and Parcel Delivery

Garbage pickup, mail delivery and parcel delivery will not be interrupted at any time during this project.
